Bill Crucial For New ATV Trails & Grant-in-Aid Program Passes In St. Paul

(An important legislative update from ATV Minnesota's lobbyists)

Two budget bills are still making their way through the 2021 1st Special Legislative Session. The not so special session anymore was convened on June 14, 2021, to finalize the budget bills not passed during the regular session. Even with the

additional time, two budget bills (Taxes & K-12 Ed) are moving towards agreement by 12:00 midnight today, Wednesday, June 30, 2021. The prospect for passage of these two bills is good at this time.

A Successful Session On Our Initiatives

We are happy to announce that the Environment & Natural Resources Finance Omnibus bill (Chpt. 6, SF20-HF5) has been passed by both bodies and signed by the Governor. So now we can safely report to you the results of our efforts.

ATV Minnesota had another successful session on our initiatives at the Capitol due to the help of many legislators and supporters. Below are outlined our successes and those issues/items we will need to monitor or act on again in the future sessions.

Appropriations:

- 1. Passed: One-time additional funding for the Prospector Trail: \$955,000 FY22
- 2. Passed: One-time additional funding for the Voyageur Trail: \$950,000 FY
- 3. Passed: One-time funding for a Statewide ATV Master Plan & trails inventory: \$250.000 FY22
- 4. Passed: Base funding increase for ATV Grant-in-Aid trails funding of \$300,000 per year. (Increases GIA funding per year in the base future funding to \$2,435,000.)
- 5. Passage of extension of funding for a prior appropriation for Prospector Trail to June 30, 2023.

Policy:

1. Our repeal of the non-controversial "low-pressure tire" language in the ATV definition statute did not pass. It was included in both bills (and supported by the DNR) going into conference committee. We will need to

- research what happened and work to get the low-pressure tire provision repealed in the future.
- 2. No action on any provisions dealing with the Outdoor Recreation Task Force
- 3. No action on any other legislative bills introduced (riding on the shoulder of state highways, etc).

Thank You To Everyone Who Supported These Efforts

Remember to say "thanks" to all the legislators who helped us with our legislation, especially the chief authors, Sen. Tom Bakk and Rep. Rob Ecklund, as well as Sen. Tomassoni, Sen. Eichorn, Sen. Ingebrigtsen, and Sen. Koran.

Other House members to thank include Rep. Sundin, Rep. Lislegard, Rep Igo, Rep. Lillie, Rep. Lueck, and Rep Heintzeman. We would also like to recognize and thank Jeff Anderson, who lobbied very effectively for the Prospector and Voyageur Trails on behalf of all ATVers! Be sure to thank him for his hard work!

------Editor's Note ----- Every Trail Decision Is A Political Decision

Planning, funding, building and maintaining ATV trails requires working closely with public officials at the township, city, county, state and federal levels. Patience, perseverance and a positive attitude are key to success.

Thanks to our long-time and very experienced lobbyists, Ray and Tom, for their work with ATV Minnesota, and to all the State Legislators who supported our initiatives this year.

We always point out that a benefit of membership in ATV Minnesota is having lobbyists working on behalf of the ATV clubs, their members and the riding public. This year's success is a great example of that.

Named 2020 ATV Instructor Of The Year

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources has named David Andrews Jr., a volunteer ATV safety instructor in Grand Rapids, as the 2020 ATV Instructor of the Year.

Andrews, an active and founding member of the Rapids Riders ATV Club, has been a volunteer ATV safety instructor and active in the DNR's Volunteer Trail Ambassador program since 2007. In that time, he's taught about 1,200 students as part of 40 classes. In addition, he's a volunteer firearms safety instructor and active in several other local and statewide conservation and community organizations.

"Whether he's teaching new riders in class, or reinforcing safe riding habits among the people he meets on the trail through his work as a Trail Ambassador, David has a long track record of helping people enjoy the outdoors safely," said DNR Conservation Officer Tom Sutherland, who is stationed in Grand Rapids. "He goes above and beyond to ensure people have the skills they need to enjoy a lifetime of safe riding."

Andrews is among the nearly 1,000 volunteer ATV safety instructors who work with DNR conservation officers to deliver ATV safety training certification. For details on safety courses and training, see

"The Master Plan review is updating this plan from 1980 and considering some new use in certain areas," said Ron Potter, ATVMN president. "Currently the only motorized use allowed on this state trail is snowmobile, some segments are being considered for OHV use under this Master Plan revision. Your comments and support of this change are needed and greatly appreciated."

The sport of ATV recreation has a large economic impact on our area; however, we are also observing the growing pains which include some poor riding behaviors and uninformed riders.




