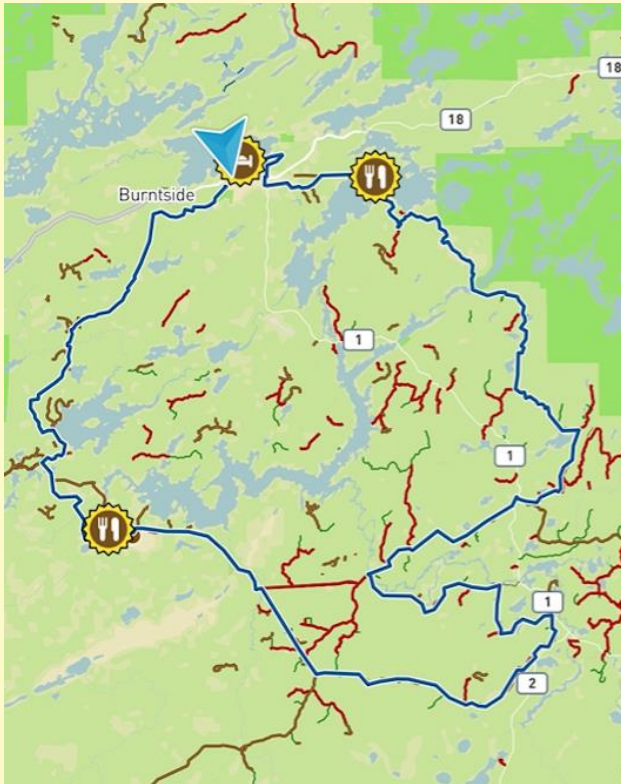
**ATV Minnesota Ride & Rally is Sept 17-19 in Ely. Check out the schedule and register today at [atvam.org](http://atvam.org).**

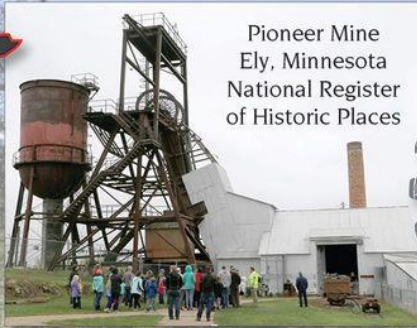
Call everyone in your group heading to Ely, check out the ride details and maps, then register for your favorite, choosing from 12 rides of varying lengths. Or choose the self-guided ride option.

**Example (map shown):  
Ride 2: Ely to Jackpot Loop  
for a picnic lunch, about 90  
miles round trip.**

Ride leaves at 9:30 a.m. from the Miners Dry in Ely (where the banquet will be held Saturday night). Group heads east on the Prospector Trail out of Ely with stops at the Kawishiwi Bridge and the Mattila Shelter. Continues to the Jackpot Loop and stop at the trailhead area for lunch featuring Zup's sausages and burgers cooked up by the Babbitt ATV and Snowmobile Club. After lunch,

back on the Jackpot Loop, over to Babbitt and onto the Prospector Trail to the Taconite. You'll get to traverse the Soular Swamp and ride the club's 1,100 foot boardwalk through a cedar swamp. The ride continues on a temporary bridge over the Beaver River and then on the newly opened Taconite Trail back to Ely.

### UTV Weight Limit Raised to 3,000 lbs in Wisconsin

In July, Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers signed into law Act 70, raising the weight limit of a UTV registered in Wisconsin from 2,000 lbs to 3,000 lbs. The Wisconsin ATV/UTV Association lobbied for the weight increase, so larger side-by-sides with cabs that are over 2,000 lbs dry weight can be properly registered and allowed on the state's ATV trails. The Association has 110 member clubs. "Our clubs, by and large, did give us their support, as long as this is the limit and (maximum width allowed) is no wider than 65 inches," said Randy Harden, WATVA president.

In Minnesota, Polaris lobbied for a similar increase in the maximum weight in the ATV definition, as it prepares to launch a new electric vehicle. ATV Minnesota and its member clubs voted to not oppose a bill they had introduced in the recent session of the State Legislature, for reasons similar to the Wisconsin Association. Due to a number of reasons, the bill did not pass. As in Wisconsin,

***Deadline July 29th***

The DNR is now accepting comments on the draft Master Plan for the David Dill/Arrowhead State Trail. The plan updates the original (1980) trail plan and will permit all existing uses, plus reviews the trail to allow OHV use. The plan as well as instructions to comment may be found under the "Master Plan Review" tab on the [trail webpage](https://www.dnr.state.mn.us/state_trails/arrowhead/index.html). Here is the link:

The 135-mile David Dill/Arrowhead State Trail extends from ten miles west of Tower at the intersection with the Taconite State Trail to Ericsburg, ten miles south of International Falls. This long-distance, natural surface trail was developed mainly for winter use and is used primarily for snowmobiling.

"The Master Plan review is updating this plan from 1980 and considering some new use in certain areas," said Ron Potter, ATVMN president. "Currently the only motorized use allowed on this state trail is snowmobile, some segments are being considered for OHV use under this Master Plan revision. Your comments and support of this change are needed and greatly appreciated."

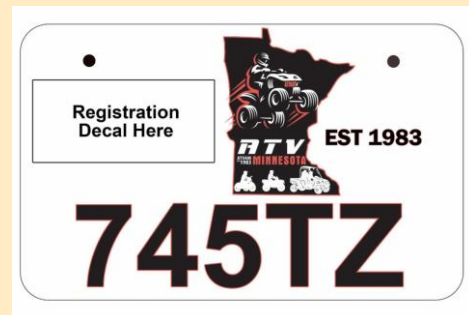
