Great news for this year's ATVMN State Convention!

The U.S. Forest Service has reopened the route from Ely to Babbitt following containment on the north and east sides of the Greenwood Fire.

"We're back on track with the guided rides for Saturday," said Prospector ATV Club president Nick Wognum. "We haven't had any smoke in Ely for over a week and with the BWCA opening back up, life is returning to normal."

There are 12 different rides for people to choose from on the website for Saturday. "If you're coming up for the VIP ride on Friday or even if you're going to

be here Friday afternoon, be sure to come to Babbitt for the ATV Big Air Show at 5 p.m. It's free and it's a going to be a great time," said Wognum.



The Ride and Rally event starts with the VIP ride on Friday followed by the Big Air Show, and rides across the Prospector Trail system on Saturday. Then it's over to the Miners Dry building at Ely's historic Pioneer Mine for the banquet and live auction.

"We're rolling out the red carpet Saturday night. We do have a limit on the number of people that can attend, so if you haven't registered yet, do so today," said Wognum.

Please register separately for the Friday VIP ride and the Saturday guided ride of your choice, or choose the self-guided option. It's all at atvam.org.

Irondale Township to allow ATVs on road right-of-way

right-of-way At a Public Hearing of the Irondale Township Planning and Zoning Committee on Tuesday, July 27, the Planning Commission recommended the Township Board rescrict the ATV ordinance which prohibits the use of ATVs on town road rightof-way and town properties with limited exceptions.

Good News In Crow Wing County: Township Ordinance Reversed, Opening Roads Once Again To ATVs

An ordinance to restrict the use of ATVs on Irondale Township roads in Crow Wing County was passed in 2007. At the time, the Cuyuna Iron Range Riders ATV club was working with the county to designate the Miller-Black Bear Trail for ATV recreation. There was much misinformation spread around the area about ATVs running all over the county, at the same time that we were trying to designate the trail area. Irondale, Wolford and Perry Lake Townships all passed ordinances to restrict the use of ATVs on their township roads.

The club continued to work with the county and the Miller-Black Bear Trail eventually became a legal riding area. Our club submitted a trail application this spring to add 12.5 miles of new trails to the area. Our club also maintains the Mississippi Northwoods Trail, and our future plans are to connect this to the Miller-Black Bear Trail. Members of our club had been in discussion with Irondale Township since early last year to remove the ordinance. We needed the use of a township road to make the trail connection to the Mississippi Northwoods Trail. The township posted the meeting in the Crosby Courier and held a public meeting on July 27; thirteen people came to support rescinding the ordinance. There was not any opposition verbally or written, and the town board members voted unanimously to remove the ordinance. Much of the success and credit goes to Dale Carry, Russ Heittola, Dave Wille, and many other club members who attended the meetings. *Ken Irish, president*

ATV Club Introduces Hundreds of Kids To Off-road Riding

Think about giving 750 kids a ride in your club's ATVs...in 6 hours. That's exactly what members of the Runestone Off-road ATV Riders (ROAR) did. It happened Sunday, August 29th, at the Youth Outdoor Activity Day, held annually in Alexandria, Minnesota. The free rides were one of 40 hands-on activities for

kids. ROAR used vehicles owned by its members or provided for the day by local ATV dealers. Kids donned hair nets and helmets, and climbed aboard a Class 1 or Class 2 ATV for an off-road ride three-quarters of a mile long. For many it was their first time on an ATV, making it a great opportunity for the club to talk about ATV safety with the kids and their parents.

Youth Outdoor Activity Day is a free family-friendly event intended to provide a fun environment for youth to learn about outdoor recreation. Activities include building a bird feeder, archery, hunting, dog training, angling and many other related skills. It is hosted and organized by two non-profit groups,Viking Sportsmen Inc. and Douglas County Pheasants Forever, and is made possible through a consortium of participating volunteer organizations, businesses, individuals, and donors.



Also on hand at this year's event was the OHV safety education trailer of the Coalition of Recreational Trail Users (CRTU). Positioned next to the ROAR exhibit, the trailer is used by CRTU board members (representing ATVMN, ARMCA, MnUSA and MN4WDA) to answer questions and provide trail maps, reg books and other handouts related to riding ATVs, dirt bikes, snowmobiles and 4WD trucks on Minnesota's State OHV trails. Hundreds of kids played two games at the booth, answering questions about OHV regulations and safe riding, and winning prizes.
