TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

In preparation for the 2023 Trail Ambassador season, the Minnesota DNR Enforcement Division is offering two **Trail Ambassador** training sessions.

Trail Ambassador Training Information

All participants will receive a reference manual and handouts. Length of training is 6 1/2 hours. Topics of instruction include emphasis on trail monitoring, trail log reporting, trail ambassador policies, equipment, and public relations expectations.

Morning refreshments and Lunch will be provided at no charge.

In order to attend, a sponsorship from a qualified off-highway vehicle organization is required. The <u>Trail Ambassador webpage</u> explains the history and qualifications.

ATV Safety Instructor Requirement

A trail ambassador is expected to be involved with youth ATV Safety certification training. A person must obtain certification as a MN DNR Volunteer Youth ATV Safety Training Instructor prior to April 1, 2023.

ATV Safety Instructor And Trail Ambassador Training Coming Up


The DNR has posted three training classes in January (14th, 17th and 21st) for ATV Safety Instructors and one for Trail Ambassadors (January 28th).

About 200 TAs currently monitor our State ATV Trails on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays during the riding season, answering questions, passing out maps and other materials, and keeping trails safe for the riding public. Clubs receive a DNR grant to reimburse their TAs for allowed expenses. There are


