> Getting A Jump On Trail Cleanup



Many State ATV Trails are a mess, with trees snapped or hanging low due to heavy wet snow. Clubs that want to get out early to clear their signed, designated Grant-in-Aid trails prior to the May 1st opener (after April 1 on GIA snowmobile trails) should coordinate with their local land



manager. Joe Unger with DNR Parks & Trails reports that maintenance contracts should be out in mid to late March. Clubs should monitor and document costs. If they use up their GIA funds during the riding season, they should apply for an amendment, making sure they keep some money in their accounts and know the amendment process.


Registration Is Now Open For The 2023 ATV MN Ride & Roast May 20th, Isle


