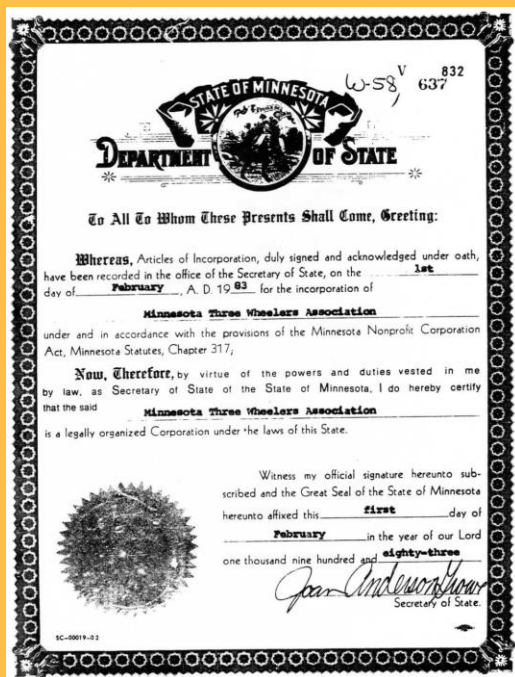

ATV MN Began As The Minnesota Three Wheelers Association

In 1983, three-wheelers were king. The very first quads were just being introduced by Suzuki, Honda and right behind them Polaris and Yamaha.

A group of off-road riders organized the Minnesota Three Wheelers Association, creating Articles of Incorporation, and on February 1st being officially recognized by the State of Minnesota as a non-profit created "to promote use and provide use areas."

On May 2, 1987, the name was officially changed to All Terrain Vehicle Association of Minnesota.

Today, that is still the official Association name. ATV Minnesota (our

primary name used in finances and communications) has over 12,000 individual, family and business members. Its 70 ATV member clubs and their dedicated members maintain the majority of the over 80 State Trails and are

building more -- using proven best practices to ensure they are fun, safe, and economically and environmentally sustainable. Together with the clubs, the ATV MN board works at the local and state level to protect access to public lands for motorized recreation, improve regulations, obtain funding, and promote safe, responsible use of ATVs.

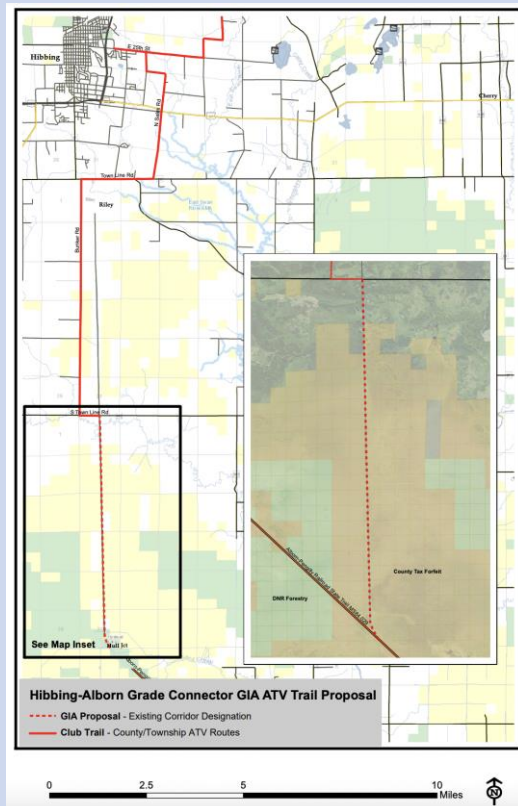
The ride is open to

DNR Seeks Input On Hibbing To Alborn ATV Trail Proposal

(There is strength in numbers. Please send your positive comments today.)

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources invites public review and written comments on a proposal by the city of Chisholm and the Northern Traxx All-Terrain Vehicle Club to obtain Grant-in-Aid funding for an all-terrain vehicle trail connection between the city of Hibbing and the Alborn-Pengilly Railroad Trail in Lavell Township.

Minnesota's Off-Highway Vehicle Trails Assistance Program — popularly known as Grant-in-Aid — is a cost-share program that facilitates development and maintenance of OHV trails, including ATV trails, at the initiative of enthusiast groups or clubs, with the support and participation of local government sponsors.

The proposed new trail, known as the Hibbing to Alborn ATV Trail, would provide an 18-mile connection between Hibbing and the Alborn-Pengilly Railroad Trail, a Grant-

in-Aid ATV trail currently open for public use. The proposed trail would follow 12.2 miles of public roads currently open for ATV use and 5.8 miles of abandoned railroad grade. The trail would be maintained by the Northern Traxx ATV Club.

The DNR will accept written comments on the proposal until 4:30 p.m. Monday, March 20. Comments may be submitted:
