Reminder To Clubs:

Don't Miss The July 30 Deadline For Your GIA Request For Reimbursement (RFR)

The Minnesota DNR fiscal year 2021 closed effective June 30, 2022.

Clubs that have Grant-In-Aid expenses related to fiscal year 2021 Grants (July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022) need to send in their Request for Reimbursement (RFR) into their GIA sponsor before the end of July 2022 to ensure reimbursement.

Missing this deadline could result in your club paying for 100% of your Grant-in-Aid trail expenses incurred in fiscal year 2021.

As a reminder, clubs should try to send in reimbursement requests on a regular basis, every 1 to 3 months, or soon after a large expense. You, your sponsor and Minnesota DNR will have a much easier time processing the RFRs before it becomes a distant memory. Thanks! *Perry May, ATVMN State Director*





TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

In preparation for the 2023 Trail Ambassador season, the Minnesota DNR Enforcement Division is offering two **Trail Ambassador** training sessions.

Trail Ambassador Training Information

All participants will receive a reference manual and handouts. Length of training is 6 1/2 hours. Topics of instruction include emphasis on trail monitoring, trail log reporting, trail ambassador policies, equipment, and public relations expectations.

Morning refreshments and Lunch will be provided at no charge

In order to attend, a sponsorship from a qualified off-highway vehicle organization is required. The <u>Trail Ambassador webpage</u> explains the history and qualifications.

ATV Safety Instructor Requirement

A trail ambassador is expected to be involved with youth ATV Safety certification training. A person must obtain certification as a MN DNR Volunteer Youth ATV Safety Training Instructor prior to April 1, 2023.

Two Trail Ambassador Training Classes Scheduled For 2023 Ride Season

The DNR has posted two new classes for Trail Ambassador training. About 200 TAs currently monitor our State ATV Trails on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays during the riding season, answering questions, passing out maps and other materials, and keeping trails safe for the riding public. Clubs receive a DNR grant to reimburse their TAs for allowed expenses. There are prerequisites, including completing training as an ATV Safety Instructor. Page one of the flyer is shown. 
