## Groundbreaking For Multi-use Trail From Warroad To Beltrami Island State Forest



On Tuesday July 19, 2022, a groundbreaking ceremony for a new, multi-use trail between Warroad and Beltrami Island State Forest was held. The 16-mile trail will provide opportunities for

numerous outdoor activities: ATV riding, biking, running, walking, and horseback riding, as well as snowshoeing, cross-country skiing and snowmobiling. Joining together to make this happen are Warroad Community Development, Roseau Lake of the Woods Sportsman Club, Roseau County Trailblazers, and local townships.

"The rail bed that runs parallel to Highway 11 for 6.5 miles to just west of the power line has a good foundation," explains Myles Hogenson, Roseau Lake of the Woods Sportsman Club member. "We will add class 5 gravel to the existing foundation, and calcium chloride to keep the dust down. When the trail turns toward Bemis Hill, geo grid underlayment and road base granite will be added to the old grade road that is already there. It's another 10.5 miles to Bemis Hill from the power lines. The trail will be 12-16 feet wide on the rail bed and 8 feet wide on the old grade road. Local contractors are building the multi-use trail, and because we only have one trail for our residents and tourists, we have to make it a good one. The trail should be open in four weeks."

## Northwoods Trail System And Trail Alliance Expand

The Over the Hills Gang ATV Club officially accepted an invitation to join the Northwoods Regional ATV Trail System Alliance. As part of the alliance, the club joins the Blind Lake, North Woods Quads, Evergreen PAC, Up North Riders, Mille Lacs Drift Skippers, and White Pine Riders ATV Clubs in managing a connective system of over 300 miles of ATV trails. It includes the Red Top, Foxy, Solana, Lawler Loops, Hill City Connector, Moose River Connector, North Soo Line / Aitkin, Moose River Connector, Emily Outing and Emily Blind Lake ATV Trails. The Over The Hills Gang club will work in partnership with the other alliance clubs to look for efficiencies in trail maintenance, marketing, and common trail signage. The trails it manages are now included on the new 2022 Northwoods ATV Trail System map published by Tidholm

Productions, Aitkin, Minn, and will be available at future club meetings.

#### TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

In preparation for the 2023 Trail Ambassador season, the Minnesota DNR Enforcement Division is offering two **Trail Ambassador** training sessions.

#### Trail Ambassador Training Information

All participants will receive a reference manual and handouts. Length of training is 6 1/2 hours. Topics of instruction include emphasis on trail monitoring, trail log reporting, trail ambassador policies, equipment, and public relations expectations.

Morning refreshments and Lunch will be provided at no charge.

In order to attend, a sponsorship from a qualified off-highway vehicle organization is required. The <u>Trail Ambassador webpage</u> explains the history and qualifications.

#### ATV Safety Instructor Requirement

A trail ambassador is expected to be involved with youth ATV Safety certification training. A person must obtain certification as a MN DNR Volunteer Youth ATV Safety Training Instructor prior to April 1, 2023.

ATV Safety Instructor Training Classes August 20 & 30 And Trail Ambassador Training Classes Scheduled For 2023 Ride Season

The DNR has posted training classes for both ATV Safety Instructors and Trail Ambassadors.

About 200 TAs currently monitor our State ATV Trails on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays during the riding season, answering questions, passing out maps and other materials, and keeping trails safe for the riding public. Clubs receive a DNR grant to reimburse their TAs for allowed expenses. There are prerequisites, including completing training as an ATV Safety Instructor. Page one of the flyer is shown.
