Civil Penalties Increased For Trespass By Snowmobiles and Off-Highway Vehicles

In an effort to promote responsible snowmobile and off-highway vehicle use — and to protect individuals who allow their land to be used for trails — civil

penalties will increase Aug. 1, 2022 for certain off-highway vehicle violations, and new civil penalties are created for certain snowmobile violations and violations of trespass laws involving an off-highway vehicle or a snowmobile. Fines for off-highway vehicle violations will increase from \$100 to \$250 for a first offense, \$200 to \$500 for a second offense and \$500 to \$1,000 for third and subsequent offenses. These increased amounts will also be the amounts for the new civil penalties for snowmobile violations and for

trespass violations involving an off-highway vehicle or snowmobile. Fines collected from citations involving snowmobiles will go to the snowmobile trails and enforcement account.

New Funding Opportunity For Projects On U.S. Forest Service Lands Webinar August 30, 2022, 12 pm Central Time

American Trails is pleased to partner with the U.S. Forest Service in announcing the Legacy Trails Grant Program. This program is funded up to \$1.5M per year for 5 years through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and supports partner trail projects that further the <u>Legacy Roads</u> and <u>Trails criteria</u> on National Forest System trails throughout the <u>nine Forest Service Regions</u>. This webinar will outline this new and exciting trails funding




opportunity. Funding is open to nonprofit organizations, businesses, and local agencies supporting trails on U.S. Forest Service lands. This webinar is intended to help members of the trail community to understand if this funding program is right for their needs and will allow plenty of time for attendee questions.

The application for this funding will be available in late September/early October. Please be sure you are on our <u>mailing list</u> to be notified as soon as more details are available.

Learning Objectives:

- Understand the Forest Service Legacy Roads and Trails criteria for this new program.
- Better comprehend the types of projects that this fund will support.
- Become familiar with the planned application process and timeline.
- Understand how project proposals will be evaluated and what it takes to submit a high-quality application.
